

## MUSIC OPPORTUNITIES AT DFUMC

### **Sanctuary Choir**

The *Sanctuary Choir* leads congregational singing and provides special music for the 10:30 worship service each Sunday and presents special performances at Christmas and Easter. All adults and older youth are encouraged to participate.

Rehearsals begin at 7:00 P.M. each Wednesday in the sanctuary—except for an eight-week hiatus each summer when music is provided by the Vacation Choir.

### **Vacation Choir**

For eight weeks each summer, the *Vacation Choir* provides service music in the southern gospel tradition for the 10:30 worship service. Adults, youth, and children are urged to participate by meeting in the church sanctuary at 10:15 before each service.

### **God's Love Chorus**

The *God's Love Chorus* leads congregational singing and provides special music for the 8:15 worship service each Sunday. It includes adults and older youth and rehearses just before each service at 7:45 A.M in Room 108.

### **Handbell Choir**

The *Handbell Choir* includes youth and adults who perform on DFUMC's 3 ½-octave set of Schulmerich bells. They rehearse on Wednesdays from 6:00 to 7:00 in the evening.

### **Children's Choir**

The *DFUMC Children's Choir* includes youngsters from age 5 through the fifth grade who prepare music for performances during worship services and for special presentations at Christmas and for Children's Sabbath. Beginning in August and continuing through the school year, they rehearse on Sunday evenings at 5:00 in room 108.

### **Youth Choir**

All youth in grades six through twelve are encouraged to participate in the *DFUMC Youth Choir*. They appear regularly in worship services and in special performances.

All Youth Choir activities are planned in coordination with the church's other programs for youth. Rehearsals are from 4:00 to 5:00 each Sunday afternoon—beginning in August and continuing throughout the school year.

### **Contemporary Worship Ensembles**

The *Contemporary Worship Ensembles* provide all who are interested in non-traditional uses of music, drama, dance, or other arts in Christian worship with opportunities to lead and contribute to the spiritual life of DFUMC. Regular meetings will be held in the Choir Room at 3:00 each Sunday afternoon. Other rehearsals or conferences will be arranged as needed.
