COVENANT OF CONDUCT**

TO INSURE THE SAFETY OF ALL, TO FACILITATE OUR TIME TOGETHER, AND TO ADEQUATELY CARE FOR THE DICKSON FIRST FACILITY, IT IS NECESSARY FOR ALL OF US TO AGREE TO OBSERVE CERTAIN GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES.

THOSE POLICIES INCLUDE:

1. Everyone will attend ALL group activities, worship services, meals and other scheduled activities.
2. No guys in girls'/girls in guys' sleeping areas or restrooms at any time.
3. Each camper is expected to observe the curfew, and respect other roommates who wish to sleep.
4. Use of tobacco, illegal drugs, and alcohol are strictly prohibited.
5. Vehicles will remain parked and unoccupied once returned from their work sites; campers are not to leave Dickson First's facility unless authorized.
6. I will be responsible for the care and proper use of Dickson's facilities.
7. I will not pull any practical jokes.

AS A REPRESENTATIVE OF CHRIST AND THE CHURCH, WE TAKE SERIOUSLY OUR RESPONSIBILITY TO ONE ANOTHER. THIS COVENANT IS AN AFFIRMATION OF OUR CONCERN FOR THE WELL-BEING OF THE TOTAL MISSION CAMP COMMUNITY.

I also realize that, in the event I am sent home, I will be forfeiting the remainder of the money already paid for the mission camp fee.

General Information

The Dickson County Mission Work Camp is sponsored by Dickson First United Methodist Church. Andrew Scott is the Youth Director.

Our goal is to reach out to the people of Dickson County with the love of Jesus Christ. We want to help those that are less fortunate than we are by repairing their homes and helping them to have a better standard of living, but we also want to share Jesus with them. We want to give teenagers the opportunity to serve their community and share their faith with others.

All people participating will need to arrive by 4:30 p.m. on Sunday and they will leave around 10:00 p.m. on Friday night. The cost is **\$165.00** per person and a deposit of \$25.00 is due with your registration by April 14, 2008. The remaining \$140.00 per person must be paid by May 16, 2008. This fee will include a T-shirt, water bottle, and a free group photo.

Requirements

1. One adult leader must participate with each group of five youth. If there are less than five youth from your church, you must still send one adult with them.
2. Each adult leader must bring a van for transportation of your work team and materials.
3. Adult leaders must be at least 19 or older.
4. Adult leaders must participate for the entire week and must be there to work for the full six hours daily.
5. Adult leaders must be present for the evening worship services.
6. No special menus will be provided.
7. Vehicles must remain parked and not leave the premises except to travel to and from the work site.
8. Other rules will be provided the first day of the camp and all participants are expected to abide by these or be sent home.

Church Support

Each church youth group that is participating in Dickson Mission camp is encouraged to support the youth of their church and our camp by:

1. Providing scholarships for youth/adults participating in the camp.
2. Provide tools and materials for Dickson Mission camp.
3. Provide food or a meal during the week.
4. Send monetary donations to purchase food or materials. *A lunch can be sponsored at \$300 per day or a dinner can be sponsored at \$400 per day.*
